CALL FOR EXTENDED ABSTRACTS

Theme: Covid 19: Labour Issues and Responses

Countries are taking unprecedented measures to combat the spread of the Covid 19, while ameliorating its pernicious effect on the economy and labour market.

The COVID-19 crisis is having a substantial impact on all aspects of our lives. The immediate focus and ongoing priority is inevitably, and correctly, on public health, and is likely to remain that way for the considerable period of time. To overcome its pernicious effect, governments, employers' and workers' organizations, WHO and the ILO have implemented policies with the instructions from health authorities.

However, there is a high degree of interest in the many other impacts of COVID-19, including economic and labour market impacts, which have been immediate and very significant, and likely to continue in the near future or potentially beyond. In the case of labour market, many millions of workers across a large number of countries including Sri Lanka have been directly impacted by lockdowns. Some are able to continue their work through teleworking or remote working arrangements. Many others have seen a reduction or complete loss of their livelihood. Others for example, workers in health or public security, experience a different type of change, that a huge increase in burden of work in the face of the crisis.

Accordingly, this Journal aims to integrate the studies that look and analyze the emerging labour issues and responses.

Title case with italicized and font size 16.

AUTHOR'S NAME

Last name with initials & font size 12 added to show the corresponding institutional address.

FULL CONTACT DETAILS

E-mail, Contact number.

INSTITUTIONAL ADDRESS

Designation of the Author and the Institutional Address, Font Size 12.

EXTENDED ABSTRACT

Could be a single paragraph or many paragraphs. Authors are encouraged to avoid small paragraphs. Scientific names should be italicized. Equations should be included without changing the spacing format.

KEYWORDS

Maximum five words, Italicized
Font size 11

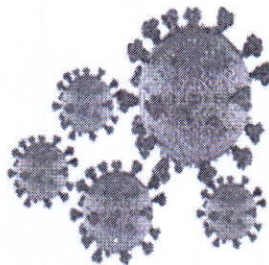
IMPORTANT DATES
